

ATV SHOOTOUT CLASS RULES

AS OF: 2/7/2023

- All NHRA Safety Rules Apply
 - 1/8 Mile Race
 - Heads Up, .500 Full Tree
- 6.39 or quicker must have NHRA Competition license
 - Random pairing sportsman ladder
 - NO AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSIONS

VEHICLE RULES: Any year ATV is allowed.

Chassis: Any type chassis is permitted. Any year ATV is allowed.

Suspension: Any type of suspension is permitted.

<u>Lights:</u> Not required.

Exhaust: Not required.

<u>Electronics:</u> Delay boxes, electronic throttle stops, and stutter boxes are prohibited.

Shifter: Any type shifter is permitted, except as noted. Air shifters and electronic shifters are prohibited. *No Auto Trans allowed.*

Fuel: Any type of fuel is allowed.

Tires: Any size/type tire is permitted.

<u>CREDENTIALS:</u> All competitors must have a competition number and membership number. Valid NHRA competition license mandatory for driver of any vehicle running 9.99 or quicker. All drivers running 10.00 seconds or slower must have a valid state- or government-issued driver's license beyond a learner's-permit level or valid NHRA competition license. See NHRA General Regulations 10:4.

TOW VEHICLES: Permitted. Vehicles must get to scales under their own power. If a vehicle is disabled and cannot get to the scales under its own power, the vehicle's crewmember(s) must stop at the scales first to notify the tech officials. A tech official will then escort the crewmember(s) in the retrieval of the vehicle.
